The camp and many of the areas we will be traveling in have limited cell phone reception. In camp, AT&T phones generally get some reception; other carriers probably will not get reception. Also most of the cabins do not have electrical outlets, so you will not be able to charge your phones, computers and other electronic devices. Please be aware of this and plan accordingly.

GPS units are helpful for navigating in the area, however please **carefully review your routing prior to the trip**; there are several places near the camp where your GPS might place you on a road that will end up trying to cross the river. **Please follow the directions that we are providing to get to the camp.**

Also please be aware that you will want to use the camp driveway at the North end of the Camp near the playing fields which will lead to the parking area. No cars will be allowed in Camp or near the cabins, so you will have to plan accordingly.

If you are taking a bus, van or car to an out of camp activity, please plan on taking all of your gear for the day with you when you leave the cabin for breakfast; the buses will be at the front gate and the vans and cars will be leaving from the parking lot at the other end of Camp. **PLEASE BE EARLY TO THE BUSES, VANS AND CARS AS WE ARE ON A TIGHT SCHEDULE AND VEHICLES WILL NOT WAIT FOR LATE ARRIVALS. IF YOU MISS A VEHICLE, YOU ARE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE AND THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OR OTHER ACCOMMODATIONS MADE.**

Being late for transportation is a major issue and means that everyone else has to wait. For safety reasons and as a courtesy to others, please make sure that you are on time for all transportation, especially vehicles coming back from outside activities.

Please remember that Mosaic and the International Event are planned and run by volunteers. As such we ask that you please be aware of your own behavior and act accordingly. We want to help and to solve problems, to the extent we can, as such please make us aware of issues. Please be aware that we have limited time and resources, so some problems may not be addressed immediately.

In addition, please be courteous and attentive to the needs of those around you, we are a community and we need to keep a positive attitude and work together. This is especially true of when we are in out of camp activities – **PLEASE FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF THE LEADERS AND STAY WITH THE GROUP AT ALL TIMES.**
